ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ACCESS TO THE SERVICE

Children or young people 0-25 years old who are able to give informed consent, as a Social Services client either as a Looked After Child or a Child in Need.

Children and Young People Leaving Care, up to 21 years of age or 25 if in further education.

Children and Young People Looked After.

Children and Young People in Need, which includes children and young people up to the age of 18;

- with mental health problems
- excluded from school
- who are asylum seekers or refugees or unaccompanied minors
- with a disability (within definition of Children Act 1989) including those going through transition
- in refuge due to homeless status
- who are homeless or in unsatisfactory accommodation
- away from home in residential accommodation, schools, secure Units and custodial settings or independent Hospitals
- who are in the Youth Justice System
- who are young carers
- who have been or who are at risk of being abused or neglected
- who are school aged mothers
